GFS History in South Africa

Girls Friendly Society (GFS) was established in 1900. According to research It was operating in big cities like Pretoria, Johannesburg, Durban, Cape Town, Grahamstown and Port Elizabeth.

Only whites were allowed to be part of it as it was operating during Apartheid regime. GFS in the world made a decision to meet after every 3 years and GFS World Council was formed to share the progress and challenges of the Organization among the member countries.

GFS World Council became aware of the exclusion of Black people in South Africa. Also, through the underground structures of movements which were against Apartheid. GFS World Council queried that exclusion and demanded the answers from the South African delegation. The response was yes there are black Anglican women in South Africa but they are the domestic workers of our houses and according to our laws cannot seat with us in meetings also they stay very far from our places.

GFS World Council put pressure requesting GFS South Africa to include Black people as people are the same in the eyes of the Lord or forfeit their membership in the GFS World Council.

GFS South Africa opted to forfeit the GFS World membership and closed it down in 1955. The then system thrown the GFS to the then Transkei Bantu stan in early sixties. The diocese of St Johns welcomed it with warm hands. Some GFS funds were used to address the general needs of the churches. GFS in Port Elizabeth built a beautiful GFS chapel at St Pauls Parish with the funds that they had at that time.

The discussions of aligning boys to GFS started in 1999. After the processes were followed the synod confirmed the boy's alignment and their Association was named Boys Friendly Society.

In South Africa the GFS/BFS is operating in 12 dioceses other diocese are in the process of establishing branches.
