Brief Information about Sierra Leone

Sierra Leone was since 1808 a British Crown Colony, the country gained independence in 1961. It has a population of 7 million people (census 2015), its capital city is Freetown, and the city is situated in North West of the country at the coast of the North Atlantic Ocean. Sierra Leone is a tropical country in West Africa, on the Atlantic coast between Guinea and Liberia. Apart from the hilly Freetown area and white-sand beaches, it is made up of mainly swampy coastal plains and plateaux, rising to uplands in the north east.

Background of GFS worldwide

As you are aware, the Girls Friendly Society (GFS) is an organization that aimed at moulding the morals and promoting the spiritual life of its membership. The GFS was founded in England some two and half centuries ago by Mary Elizabeth Townsend; firstly to stop delinquencies in girls and women.

This initiative needs to be applauded because it sets the pace for close collaboration between the girls and women and even between boys and men, as we have thought it fit to join forces with them for the effective implementation of God's word and execution of programmes and projects at national and international level which is in line with our motor: "Bear one another's Burdens and so fulfil the law of Christ." (Galatians 6:2).

GFS Sierra Leone

GFS was inaugurated in Sierra Leone some 51 years ago by a Mothers' Union Worker Mrs. Lucretia Gordon (of blessed memory) who joined forces with other seasoned Anglican women after she returned home from a meeting in England.

Because of their hard work and devotion to the Society, it spread almost all over the Anglican Churches in the country.

It was the first African country that hosted the World Council under the leadership of Mrs. Subuola Thompson who met her demise in March 2021. May her soul rest in perfect peace.

We are truly sorry and repent of all our sins. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, who died for us, forgive us all that is past; and grant that we may serve you in newness of life to the glory of your name, Amen!

The Forgiveness

If there is Bishop or priest pronounce the absolution:

Almighty God, who forgives all who repent, has mercy on you, Pardon and deliver you from all your sins, Confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, And keep you in life internal; Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen!

Or a leader may say the following prayers:

Merciful Lord, grant to your faithful people pardon and peace, that we may be cleansed from all our sins, and may be free to serve you with peace in our hearts, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

10 And the king of Israel sent to the place which the man of God told him and warned him of, and saved himself there, not once nor twice.

11 Therefore the heart of the king of Syria was sore troubled for this thing; and he called his servants, and said unto them, Will ye not shew me which of us is for the king of Israel?
